Tour Breakdown

MEXICO CITY (INCL. DINNER)

Arrive to Mexico City Airport and check in to your hotel. Enjoy a welcome dinner at the Villa Maria restaurant.

DAY 2 – MEXICO CITY (INCL. BREAKFAST, LUNCH)

Begin your tour of Mexico City with a stop at the Constitution Plaza, or Zocalo. This city square sits in the center of several architecturally astounding historic buildings. Visit the Supreme Court building, the Metropolitan Cathedral and the archaeological site of Templo Mayor. Then stop at the National Palace to admire the famous murals of Diego Rivera. Continue with a visit to Chapultepec Park, as well as the Anthropology Museum. Finally, peruse some of the most interesting neighborhoods of Mexico City, including the charming San Angel and the modern Santa Fe.

DAY 3 – MEXICO CITY, TEOTIHUACAN PYRAMIDS, THE GUADALUPE SHRINE (INCL. BREAKFAST, LUNCH)

Explore the Plaza of Three cultures, where Aztec, Spanish Colonial and contemporary elements combine to create a wonderful, multi-faceted atmosphere. Next, discover the archaeological site of Teotihuacan and take in the grandeur of its great pyramids, temples and avenues. After lunch return to Mexico City for a visit to the celebrated Guadalupe Shrine, one of the most visited Catholic pilgrimage sites worldwide.

DAY 4 – CUERNAVACA, TAXCO (INCL. BREAKFAST, LUNCH)

Venture outside Mexico City for a short trip to Cuernavaca. Known as the “City of Eternal Spring,” it houses important landmarks such as the Cortez Palace and the Cathedral, one Mexico’s oldest buildings. Next, stroll through the narrow streets amid the colonial buildings of Taxco. This silver mining city teems with old-style charm. See the gold-plated altars of the Santa Prisca church and visit the La Borda Plaza. After lunch at a local restaurant, return to Mexico City for an afternoon of leisure.

DAY 5 – CHOLULA, PUEBLA (INCL. BREAKFAST, LUNCH)

Today, discover some of the marvelous attractions that surround Mexico City. Travel through picturesque pine country to Cholula, a significant ceremonial center of the pre-Hispanic period. Along the way, watch for a fantastic view of the legendary Ixtacihuatl and Popocatepetl volcanoes. In Cholula, see the church that sits atop one of the world’s largest pyramids before heading to the city of Puebla for more of Mexico’s architectural treasures.

DAY 6 – MEXICO CITY, COYOACAN, XOCHIMILCO (INCL. BREAKFAST)

Tour the delightful neighborhood of Coyoacan. Once a distinct town, it is now a part of Mexico City. The home of historical Spanish conqueror, Hernan Cortez is located here, now a government office. Visit La Casa Azul, or The Blue House, a museum devoted to the celebrated Mexican artist Frida Kahlo. En route to Xochimilco, stop at the Universidad Autonoma de Mexico to admire the murals of Juan O’Gorman. Once in Xochimilco, board a trajinera to navigate through the area’s beautiful canals. Return to the hotel and spend your last evening in Mexico City at your leisure.

DAY 7 – RETURN FLIGHT (INCL. BREAKFAST)
